NCW COMMEMORATES "RISE AND LEAD: YOUNG WOMEN PIONEERING IN TECHNOLOGY, BUSINESS AND PUBLIC LIFE"

NCW launched a significant initiative titled 'Rise and Lead: Young Women Pioneering in Technology, Business, and Public Life.' The NCW is hosting seminars throughout India with the goal of stimulating minds, strengthening capacities, and sharing leadership insights. These seminars aim to inspire college girls nationwide by equipping them with leadership skills and providing valuable perspectives from experts in technology, public affairs, and corporate sectors.





NCW collaborated with Graphics Era Hill University, Dehradun to conduct the workshop, 'Rise and Lead' on April 16, 2024. During her speech, Honorable Chairperson Ms. Rekha Sharma emphasized the importance of women rising up to lead the nation.

Parhi, ADG RPF, Sri Nikhil Tikaram DM of Chandauli, and Dr. Anil Kumar SP of Chandauli joined the program. Hon'ble Chairperson of NCW Ms. Rekha Sharma delivered a powerful speech. Former DG Mr. P.M. Nair also contributed valuable insights to the event. Over 200 participants from social welfare organizations, Anti-Human Trafficking Units (AHTUs) of Eastern Central Railway, and RPF personnel from DDU Junction joined the NCW at Mughalsarai, Uttar Pradesh, as part of their ongoing mission to raise awareness on the critical issue of human trafficking alongside the RPF.
