NCW COMMEMORATES INTERNATIONAL WOMEN'S DAY NATIONWIDE WITH THE "TU BOL..." PROGRAM



The National Commission for Women commemorated International Women's Day with the 'Tu Bol...' program, featuring remarkable women who shared their inspiring journeys and the hurdles they overcame. This initiative aims to empower voices and celebrate resilience. Notable figures such as Ms. Saina Nehwal (Indian Badminton Player), Ms. Ritu Karidhal (Rocket Woman of India), Sister BK Shivani (Spiritual Guide), Ms. Pragya Prasun (Social Activist and Acid Attack Survivor), and Ms. Neha Joshi (Youth Political Leader) participated, inspiring women with their words. During the event, NCW Chairperson Ms. Rekha Sharma delivered a keynote address, highlighting her personal journey of advocating for what's right and standing up for the voiceless, despite facing criticism. She urged women to embrace their own voices, speak up, and never wait for someone else to do it for them.

The inaugural event took place on March 2, 2024, in Jammu, as part of a larger multi-zone effort. 
