



The following decisions were taken at the meeting:-


1. The SRO and the Legal Cell may put up pending proposals pertaining to camps /LACs/PMLAs/ Seminars/ Studies expeditiously. The Screening Committee may meet as and when required and examine all the pending proposals.
2. Major National level Seminars/Workshops need to be planned in the February and March, 2010.
 - i) Seminar on NRI marriages at Delhi (NRI Cell) assisted by R& S Cell and Administration.
 - ii) Consultation with the National Law School, Bangalore on Memorandum of Understanding and Gender Justice Reporter. (Legal Cell)
 - iii) Implementation of the PWDV Act at Patna.(Legal Cell)

- iv) Seminar on relationship in the nature of marriage and maintenance at Mumbai or Pune. (Legal Cell)
- v) Seminar on Dayan Pratha and Violence Against Women at Bhubneshwar (R&S Cell).
- vi) Seminar on Impact of HIV AIDS on Women at Kolkata(R&S Cell)
- vii) Implementation of the PC PNDT Act at Delhi (Legal Cell)
- viii) Finalisation of guidelines on women working in call centres and night shifts at Kolkata in collaboration with Bengal National Chamber of Commerce (Legal Cell).

3. Regional and State level Seminars be conducted at Chhitorgarh, Udaipur, Sawai Madhopur, Dibrugarh, Jorhat, Sibsagar. The R&S Cell may suggest suitable topics for the same which could be conducted through local NGOs, Universities, District Administration. Members are requested to kindly forward the proposals, if any. (R+S cell)

4. The Commission also noted that action on renovating of the NCW premises has not gain any momentum. The Administration is directed to take immediate necessary action so that proper seating and other arrangement could be done without further delays. (Action by Administration)
