MINUTES F THE 24TH MEETING OF THE NATIONAL COMMISSION FOR WOMEN HELD ON 21ST JUNE, 1996.

Item No.: 5 Establishment of Pre-litigation Centre

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The arrangements so far made for holding the iference of IC Prisons were explained.

It was decided that Bangalore will be a venue in Ith for holding one of the functions related to the mpletion of one year tenure of the Commission. For the rpose, the convenience of the Prime Minister will have be ascertained. This work will be attended to by Shri nha, Consultant. In the holding of function at Bangalore e National Association of Voluntary Organisations will nder assistance. After the Prime Minister has given a te, the Conference of the State Commissions for Women y be fixed. In case, there is a clash of dates, the nference of State Commission for Women may be convened 26.07.1996. It was also decided that the travel sistance of NCW to the State Commissions for irticipating in the proposed national level conference ly be restricted to one air-fare and two AC rail fare per ach Commission.

It was also decided that for the function to be ttended by the Prime Minister at Bangalore two main ctivities will be prominent: (1) family courts; and (2) chabilitation of Devadasis.

Further, all national level NGOs, Women's Studentres, Women Universities, State Social Welfare Advisor oards, State Commissions for Women, Women MPs, Women ournalists, sister national level Commissions, women olice and women ambassadors, State Department of Women Child Development, Member of Expert Committees of NCW willow invited.
