- II. Financial approval for selected 14 Non NER Research Studies for the F.Y. 2021-22. This could entail the expenditure of Rs.1.95 Crore (Rupees One Crore Ninety Five Lakhs). Out of this, Rs.97.99 Lakh (Rupees Ninety Seven lakhs Ninety Nine Thousand only) will be required to be released as 1<sup>st</sup> installment i.e. 50% of the sanctioned amount, after receipt of requisite documents.
- III. Financial approval for selected 2 NER Research Studies for the F.Y. 2021-22. This could entail the expenditure of Rs.26,40,450/- (Rupees Twenty Six Lakhs Forty Thousand Four Hundred Fifty only). Out of this, Rs.13,20,225 (Rupees Thirteen Lakhs Twenty Thousand Two Hundred & Twenty Five only) will be required to be released as 1<sup>st</sup> installment i.e. 50% of the sanctioned amount, after receipt of requisite document.
